

Migrations of the Family of Henry Sinnock who migrated from Hailsham to Margate, Kent to marry Mary Wood



- A** *Thomas Sennock, Henry's grandfather born in Eastbourne moved to the Hailsham and married Elizabeth Looker and there raised 4 children including James, Henry's father born in Hailsham in 1732. James married Sarah Marshall also from Hailsham and raised a family of 7 children there, including Henry*
- B** *Henry Sinnock, son of James and Sarah born in Hailsham in 1778, moved to Margate, Kent to marry Mary Wood in 1802 where they raised a family of 7 children*
- C** *William Sinnock, Henry and Mary's son born in Margate in 1812 migrated to Bristol, Gloucestershire where he and Susan Matthews from nearby Somerset County raised a large family, perhaps 14 children*
- D** *John Sinnock, Henry and Mary's grandson born in Margate in 1829, and Emma Tester moved their whole family in about 1860 from nearby Herne Bay inland to Canterbury, where descendants still live*
- E** *William Sinnock, another grandson of Henry and Mary born in Margate in 1835, moved to Islington, London to marry Mary East where they raised 5 children*
- F** *Edward William Sinnock, William and Mary's grandson born in London in 1893 married Dorothy Manton and had 2 children with her in Lancashire; when Dorothy died in 1926, he migrated to the Grass Valley area of Colfax County, California where he married Ruth Oliver and had a son, Robert Oliver Sinnock*
- G** *Donald Leslie Wilmot Sinnock, William and Susan's great grandson born in Bristol, immigrated to New York State in 1925 where he and Mabel Curnock had 2 sons, still living in Connecticut and New York*
