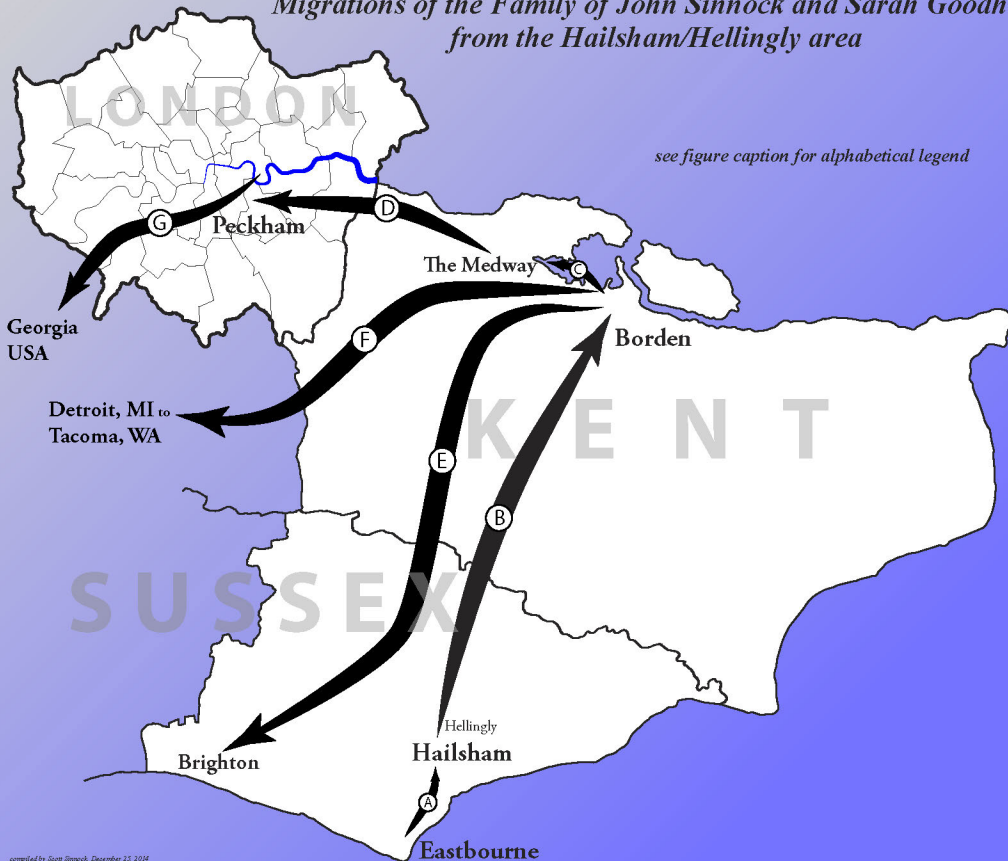


*Migrations of the Family of John Sinnock and Sarah Goodhew
from the Hailsham/Hellingly area*



- A** *Thomas Sennock*, John's grandfather born and raised in Eastbourne moved to the Hailsham area to marry Elizabeth Looker and there raised 4 children including **James**, John's father born there in 1732
- B** *John Sinnock*, Thomas and Eliza's grandson born in Hailsham in 1763, moved to the Bredgar-Borden area of Kent to marry Sarah Goodhew in 1787 where they raised a family of 8 children
- C** *William Sinnock*, John and Sarah's son born in Bredgar in 1762, moved to the nearby Medway area to marry Ann Whitehead in Rochester and had a son William in Chatham who had 101 known descendants
- D** *Alfred William Sinnock*, William and Ann's grandson born in the Medway (Gillingham) in 1839 moved to London to marry Emma Gibb; they settled in the Peckham area of London and raised a large family
- E** *Alfred Sinnock*, John and Sarah's, grandson born in West Malling just south of Borden in 1846, migrated back to the Sussex coast at Brighton where he married Mary Ann Silverstone and raised a large family
- F** *John W. Sinnock*, John and Sarah's son born in Borden in 1810, married Sarah Swift Coultrup; they had 9 children, 5 died as infants and one at 17. Sarah died in 1867 and he then took his surviving sons, William Swift, Jesse Lee, and James Walter to Michigan then on to Puget Sound of Washington
- G** *Russell William James Sinnock*, great grandson of Alfred William and Emma born in Peckham in 1921, immigrated to Florida and Georgia where he married Nell Grace Roush and raised a daughter, Della
