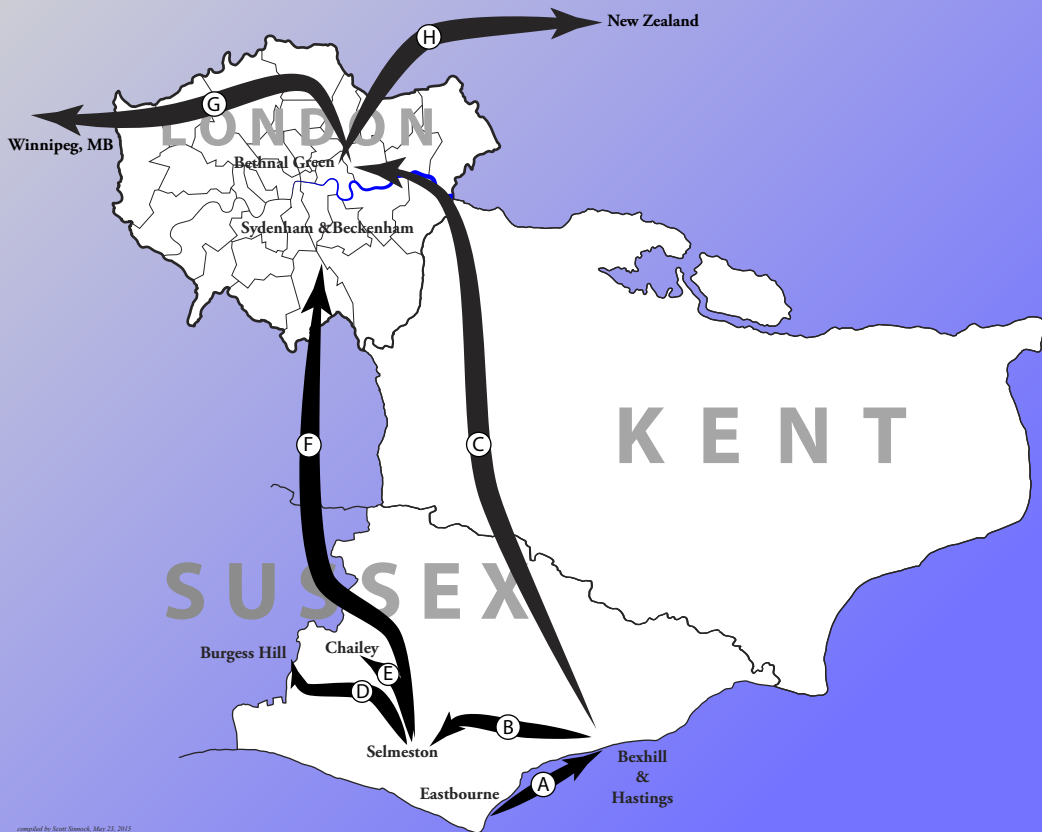


Migrations of the Descendants of William Sinnock and Mary Langford

(William is the 2nd child of Elias Sinnock and Margery Frankwell from Eastbourne, Sussex)



- A** William Sinnock, born in Eastbourne in 1652 to Elias Sinnock and Margery Frankwell traveled just up the coast in 1693 to Bexhill where he wed Mary Langford and there they raised a large family
- B** John Sinnock, William and Mary's grandson, born in Crowhurst, near Bexhill, raised a family in Selmeston, just about 10 miles inland with Susanna Claire mostly in the 1760's
- C** George Sinnock, William and Mary's great grandson, born in Hasting, near Bexhill in 1788, traveled to Shoreditch, London where he married Sarah Govey in 1817 and raised a family
- D** Thomas Sinnock, John and Susanna's grandson, born in West Firle, near Selmeston in 1806 traveled to Ditchling just across the border from Burgess Hill where he married Harriet in 1835 and raised a family
- E** James sinnock, John and Susanna's grandson, born in Selmeston in 1825 traveled to Chailey where he married home-town Ann Brooks in 1850 and there raised a large family
- F** Frederick Sinnock, John and Susanna's great grandson, born in Selmeston in 1848 traveled to London where he married Anne Rebecca Blake in 1871 and raised a large family in Beckenham, London
- G** Samuel Thomas Sinnock, George and Sarah's possible great grandson, born in Bethnal Green, London and Jane Mary Watts from Whitechapel migrated to Winnipeg in 1902 and raised a large family there
- H** William George Sinnock, George and Sarah's possible 2nd great grandson, born in Bethnal Green in 1915 and Elsie Earl migrated to New Zealand in 1951 and raised a family there.
